

# Construction Update

January 16, 2025






The Ladyface Greenway Project will involve utility work in your area starting Tuesday, January 21, 2025. The overall utility work is expected to take about 4-months to complete. The preliminary investigation (potholing) is the first phase of the utility work and will take 2-weeks, followed by underground conduit installation. This work is necessary for essential infrastructure upgrades and will result in temporary daytime lane closures. While these closures may cause some disruptions, efforts will be made to minimize the impact on your business. Full road closures will not occur, but drivers and bicyclists should be prepared to stop for flaggers to ensure their safety. The project team appreciates your understanding and cooperation and will provide updates if the schedule changes.

## WHAT TO EXPECT, SHARE THE ROAD

-  Vehicle and Bike Lane Closures on Agoura Rd. & Cornell Rd.
-  Share the Road with Bicyclists & Pedestrians
-  Detours, Signage & Traffic Delays
-  Temporary One Lane Roads, Follow Flagger Instructions
-  Reduced Speed Limits

Please be aware that due to the dynamic nature of construction and potential weather delays, certain work activities may take longer than initially anticipated.

## TIPS FOR DRIVERS, BIKERS AND PEDESTRIANS

**Stay Alert:** Pay attention to signs, flaggers, and changes in traffic patterns. Be aware of cyclists.

**Allow Extra Time:** Be prepared for longer travel times, especially during peak hours.

**Follow Instructions:** Comply with temporary traffic signs and signals.

**Use Alternative Routes:** If possible, use alternate routes to avoid major delays.
